Four great Rums (15ml taster) that demonstrate the range of styles and flavour profiles available for your enjoyment. Try neat or with your favourite mixer (add £1.95)

Old Monk

Old Monk Rum is a vatted Indian dark rum, launched in 1954. It is a dark rum with a distinct vanilla flavour, with most expressions spiced, aged in oak barrels, and bottled at an alcohol content of 42.8% ABV

Mount Gay

Mount Gay Black Barrel is a robust, blended Barbados rum (43% ABV) aged 3–7 years in American whiskey casks, then finished for six months in deeply charred bourbon casks. It offers bold notes of toasted vanilla, toffee, spice, and gingerbread, making it excellent for cocktails like the Old Fashioned.

Don Pappa

Don Papa Rum, a premium aged, single-island rum from the Philippines. Where it is distilled in small-batches on the foothills of the active volcano Mt. Kanlaon, where the finest sugar cane is milled to produce sweet, rich molasses. Don Papa Rum is then aged in American Oak barrels for 7 years. Full of Vanilla Flavour and a hint of spice!

Ron Zacapa Solera 23

A benchmark rum for many, Ron Zacapa is made from the first press of sugar cane and aged high in the Guatemalan mountains, where it benefits from cooler temperatures that slow maturation and deepen its character. Using the solera method, it combines spirits aged between six and 23 years to create consistent flavour. Expect aromas of caramel, vanilla, cocoa and dried fruit, followed by a palate of honeyed sweetness, spices and a long, velvety finish with hints of molasses and smoke.
